### Entry Rules

1. Entry fee is 10% of 1<sup>st</sup> place premium.
2. Entry deadline is July 1, 2002, at 6pm. Entries made in the wrong class will be disqualified. Health certificates must accompany each entry.
3. No animal may be entered in more than 1 individual class. No more than 2 entries per class, except Classes 25, 26 and the Herdsman's Awards which may only be entered 1 per farm/family unit.
4. Animals exhibited must be owned by the exhibitor for 30 days before the opening date of Fair.
5. When there is only 1 entry in the class, the judge will determine the placing from 1 of the paid places.
6. Feed and bedding **will not** be provided by the Society.
7. For Sunday night milking, cows must be in by Sunday, July 14, at 5pm. All cows must be in no later than Monday, July 15, at 5pm.
8. Those wishing to leave their cattle until Monday may do so by contacting the Cattle Superintendent so that milking arrangements can be made.
9. **Release time for cattle is Sunday, July 21, at 9pm!!! Exhibitors leaving before 9pm will forfeit their premium money.**
10. Certificates of registration must be on the fairgrounds during the length of the Fair. They must be produced upon request from either the Superintendent of the Cattle Department or the Judge.
11. **A season ticket must be purchased to receive helper's passes.**

### Health Requirements

Saratoga County Agricultural Society requires all cattle to be immunized against **rabies**. A certificate of rabies vaccination signed by an accredited veterinarian must be presented to gain entrance to the fairgrounds. Cattle with warts will not be allowed on the fairgrounds.

All exhibits must be accompanied by health certificates signed by an approved veterinarian. Health papers must arrive with the animals and remain for the week. All health certificates will be checked by an official during the Fair. A state veterinarian will inspect all cattle exhibits as soon after arrival as possible. Any

animals not meeting state health requirements will need to be removed from the fairgrounds promptly.

For other health requirements for the control and suppression of infectious or communicable disease relating to domestic animals, see Ag and Markets rules in this handbook.

### Special Awards

#### Premier Breeder/Exhibitor Awards

Awards are based on the exhibitor on the highest 6 or less animals in each breed who accumulates the highest total points under the following system. If a tie occurs, the points will be calculated based on the next animal (7<sup>th</sup>).

### Class Descriptions

Date of birth of each animal must appear on the entry blank.

Get-of-Sire classes to consist of 3 animals, the get-of-sire. Junior Get-of-Sire must contain animals from Classes 1-7 only. Senior Get-of-Sire must contain animals from Classes 10-17 only.

Three best females classes to consist of 3 animals that are owned and bred by the exhibitor. Junior 3 best females must be from Classes 1-7 only. Senior 3 best females must be from Classes 10-17 only.

Dairy herd to consist of 3 animals from Classes 10-18.

Exhibitor's herd to consist of 4 females: calf, yearling and 2 animals that have calved at least once. They must be owned by the exhibitor.

Produce of Dam to consist of 2 animals, any age, the produce of 1 cow.

### *Albert Boice Memorial Herdsman Award*

Prizes: 1<sup>st</sup> \$25 2<sup>nd</sup> \$20 3<sup>rd</sup> \$15 4<sup>th</sup> \$10

To herdsman in charge of cattle exhibits with 4 or more animals who make the best records covering the entire period of the Fair. This takes into consideration: personal appearance in and out of the show rings; neat arrangement of tack, feed storage, motor vehicles; and general cooperativeness. There is no entry fee in this section; you must note "Albert Boice Award" on your entry form. The top herdsman at the Saratoga County Fair will be awarded the "Al Boice Trophy." In addition, his or her name and the year will be engraved on the plaque which is displayed in the Fair office.

### *Saratoga County Fair Herdsman Award*

This class is for those families with less than 4 animals and those entering the Al Boice Award and not placing. You can win only 1 of the 2 herdsman awards and only 1 per farm/family. This takes into consideration: personal appearance in and out of the show rings; neat arrangement of tack, feed storage, motor vehicles; and general cooperativeness. There is no entry fee required for this section. You must note "Saratoga County Fair Herdsman Award" on your entry form.
