Exhibitors participating in the County Resident Show must house their animals on the fairgrounds for the entire week of the Fair. All exhibitors entering the County Resident Show and the ADGA Open Doe Show see "Rules and Regulations" under Open Doe Show.

Exhibitors must have a Health Certificate that has been signed within 30 days prior to Fair by an accredited veterinarian. Any animal that does not pass the health check will be dismissed from the fairgrounds.

All animals must be dehorned or polled.

ADGA registration or recordation certificates of all animals 6 mos. of age or older is required. A completely filled out, signed bill of sale or certificate of transfer attached to the duplicate will be accepted as proof of ownership. A completely filled out and signed certificate of transfer or the certificate of registry/recordation will be accepted as proof of ownership.

### Rules and Regulations

1. Official ADGA Show and all ADGA rules shall govern.
2. Competition is open to all.
3. Health papers are required (General Health Regulations as required at all Fairs as outlined by NYSATM). Each exhibitor shall present a health certificate signed by a veterinarian within 30 days of show date.
4. ADGA registration or recordation certificate for any animal 6 mos. of age or older is required. The registration or recordation or the stamped duplicate application showing the date received by the ADGA office is required for any animal under 6 mos. of age.
5. Exhibitors must bring their animals to the fairgrounds on Sunday morning, July 21, prior to 9am for inspection. Only those exhibitors who are participating in the Saratoga County and 4H shows earlier in the week need to house their animals on the fairgrounds for the entire week of the Fair.
6. Age of all animals in this department will be computed from the date of birth to the date of the show.
7. All Best of Breed animals must remain on the grounds until the end of the show to make the Best Doe in Show official.
8. Junior Division consists of does under 24 months of age that are not in milk and have never freshened.
9. Senior Division consists of does that have freshened or are in milk. This includes dry milkers.
10. Get-of-Sire and Dam and Daughter are not required to be owned by 1 exhibitor. Borrowing is allowed.
11. All animals shall be entered at the sole risk of the owner. The Saratoga County Agricultural Society cannot be responsible for

any loss, damage, accident to any person, animal or property while at the fairgrounds.

### Entries

1. Pre-entries postmarked by July 8 are \$2 per goat or group class. All entries postmarked later than July 8 will be considered post-entries and the fee will be \$3 per goat or group class. Post-entries will be taken day of show.
2. One exhibitor per vehicle will be admitted free at Gate 1 on the day of the show.
3. Showmanship classes will begin at 9am
  - a. Novice 10 & under or never shown before
  - b. Junior 11-13 inclusive
  - c. Senior 14-19 inclusive

These classes will be judged on the Danish system.

Showmanship classes register day of show.

4. All classes of 1 breed will be completed before continuing with next breed.

### Awards

1. Ribbons will be given up to and including 5<sup>th</sup> place.
2. Premiums will be paid for each class of 4 or more entries.
  - a. Junior Division premiums will be:

1<sup>st</sup> \$7 2<sup>nd</sup> \$5
  - d. Senior Division premiums with under 4 per class will be:  
1<sup>st</sup> \$10 2<sup>nd</sup> \$8
  - e. Group Class premiums will be:  
1<sup>st</sup> \$10 2<sup>nd</sup> \$8 3<sup>rd</sup> \$6 4<sup>th</sup> \$4
  - f. Champion Challenge Class premiums will be:  
1<sup>st</sup> \$10 2<sup>nd</sup> \$8 3<sup>rd</sup> \$6 4<sup>th</sup> \$4
3. ADGA rosettes will be given to all Champions and Reserve Champions of each breed.
4. Trophies and special awards will be donated.
5. Payment of premiums will be within 30 days from last day of Fair.
