### Rules and regulations

Entries close Monday, July 8, at 6pm.  
Entries made in the wrong class will be disqualified.

- All poultry shall have originated from US pullorum clean flocks and have a negative pullorum typhoid test within 90 days of Fair. A copy of this test must accompany your entry form. Pullorum testing will be available on the fairgrounds in June. Contact the 4H office at 885-8995 for date and time. Testing must be done within 90 days prior to Fair.
- Minimum age for chicks is 4 months or older, for bantams 3 months or older, for standard birds, ducks and geese fully feathered. Younger chicks will not be allowed.
- The Society reserves the right to put 2 birds in 1 cage provided same belongs to 1 exhibitor. In no instance will 2 male birds be placed together.
- Birds may be brought in on Monday, July 15, from 9am until noon and from 4pm to 6pm.
- The American Standard of Perfection will be the guide of the judges upon the varieties therein described. Due allowance shall be made for lack of plumage dependent upon the season.
- No premium shall be awarded on birds not true to the breed or which are sick or of low vitality or which in any way are unworthy of a prize.
- Birds shown in trios will not be allowed to compete singly.
- A trio of old stock must consist of 1 cock and 2 hens. Of young stock, 1 cockrel and 2 pullets.

9. All birds must be picked up Sunday after 9pm but before 11:30pm. Access for vehicles may be limited at this time. Other arrangements must be made with the Superintendent prior to Sunday of Fair.

10. Entries are made at the exhibitor's risk. Saratoga County Agricultural Society will not be responsible for the health of the birds.

*All exhibitors are encouraged to check on their poultry during Fair week and be present during judging or premiums will be forfeited.*
