Rules and regulations

1. Exhibitors participating in the Saratoga County Show must house their animals on the fairgrounds the entire week of the Fair.
2. Exhibitors must have a Health Certificate that has been signed within 30 days prior to Fair by an accredited veterinarian. Any animal that does not pass the health check will be dismissed from the fairgrounds.
3. **No boars allowed.**
4. Gilts entered in breeding classes cannot be shown in market classes, and gilts entered in market classes cannot be shown in breeding classes.
5. Market entries must be farrowed after December 1 of the preceding year.
6. Meat breeds only for competitive exhibits.
