### Entry Rules and Class Descriptions

Bees, Honey and Honey Products is an open class that is open to all residents.

**Entry Fee is 15% of 1<sup>st</sup> place premium.**

**Entries close on Saturday, June 27, at 6pm. Entries made in the wrong class will be disqualified.**

**Entries must be brought in on Monday, July 13, between the hours of 9am and 5pm. Entries may be removed on Monday, July 20, between the hours of 11am and 3pm.**

Honey judging will be Tuesday, July 14, 11am.

All products exhibited in this department except queen bees must be raised and produced by the exhibitor. Honey and wax will be judged with reference to quality, cleanliness, and container. **No labels on entries.**

Queens must be caged or marked on comb so they can be found at any time.

- 1 One pound queenline or classic jar extracted honey-light
- 2 One pound queenline or classic jar extracted honey-amber
- 3 One pound queenline or classic jar extracted honey-dark
- 4 One square section comb honey-light
- 5 One square section comb honey-dark
- 6 One ross round section comb honey-light-2 clear sides
- 7 One ross round section comb honey-dark-2 clear sides
- 8 One half comb section (4x4) comb honey-light
- 9 One half comb section (4x4) comb honey-dark
- 10 One section cut comb honey (4 ¼ x 4 ¼ clear box)-light
- 11 One section cut comb honey (4 ¼ x 4 ¼ clear box)-dark
- 12 One pound jar finely granulated honey (tall round jar)
- 13 One pound jar chunk honey (tall round jar)-light
- 14 One pound jar chunk honey (tall round jar)-dark
- 15 One frame wide observation hive with queen

### Section 3: Artistic Items Made with Bees' Wax

Prize money: 1<sup>st</sup> \$3 2<sup>nd</sup> \$2

- 31 Beeswax Block-Natural, unbleached, 100% beeswax, must be a 1 lb minimum weight block, square, round, or rectangular in shape.
- 32 Beeswax Candles-may be single candle, pair, or set of candles; may be dipped, molded, or rolled sheets. No non-beeswax enhancement is allowed. Entry weight: 0.5 to 2 lbs.
- 33 Artistic Beeswax-100% beeswax, 1 lb minimum weight, may be more than 1 piece but must be firmly joined together; may be cast in a mold or carved. No non-beeswax enhancement is allowed.
